

### Monthly Mission

Our monthly mission for March and April is our very own Community Meal. We have been serving 80-100 people the second Saturday of each month. As you know the cost of food has gone up and donations are down so to sustain this mission we have added it to our monthly mission this year. It is hard to believe there are so many that struggle with food insecurities. Here are some numbers put out from Neighbor's Food Shelf located in South St. Paul:

- \* Minnesotans made a record-breaking 7.5 million visits to food shelves in 2023. This is up 36.4% from previous record of 5.5 million visits in 2022, and up 102% from 3.7 million in 2021 \*Since 2019, food shelf visits at Neighbors, Inc. have increased 400%
- \*From July 2022 to June 2023 Neighbors distributed 901,379lbs of food to our neighbors in need.

If you know someone that could use a hot, home cooked meal please let them know about our community dinner. They can get it to go or eat here.

If you would like you can host a meal. You need to come up with a menu (we have a 3 ring binder with past meals) and then you can get volunteers to come help you. You can reimbursed up to \$300 for the meal. Also if needed we will get a Thrivent Action Team to help with the cost.

We are always looking for volunteers to help with the dinner and donations of desserts. If you would like to help but don't know how to get started we can help with that. Contact the Church office at anytime.



Thank you to everyone that purchased a Gerten's Plant Gift Card. Every little bit helps in our fundraising efforts. We currently are only half way to our goal. We set a high goal because we would like to have continuing funds for traveling back to Africa for another mission trip. We know the cost is what holds a lot of people back from going and we want to have those interested the chance to go. If you can help please consider making a pledge. If you make a pledge over \$50 you will be invited to a special dinner when we get back. This will be a personal dinner where you will get to ask questions and hear more about the trip.

When we arrive we will be visiting the hospital and orphanage. Then we will be in our companion village, Kimala, for 3 days. The visit to our companion village is always the highlight! On our way to Kimala we will be stopping at the Bomalange school to spend some time. This is a smaller school that receives very few visitors. A few of the children that we have raised scholarships for go to this school and we will be able to meet them. This is very exciting!

Prayers, Presence, and Projects is why we do these mission trips to Africa. We have helped support the village in Kimala, Africa for a very long time. It is important that we go there and have a presence. This is how we know what the village needs, what we are supporting, and making sure it happens! We also deepen our relationships, which is the most important aspect of our partnership, along with prayer. Thank you for your prayers and support as we prepare for the journey.


Next month we will include February and March finances in the Beacon.
